The WFP is the largest humanitarian organization in the world and has provided food to an average of 90 million people in at least 80 of the world's countries.

Although the concert will be held indoors, the staff of WEGLfest hopes to bring the outdoor festival feel inside. Several food vendors will be present including Moe's, Papa Johns Pizza, Firehouse Subs, and Taylor's Bakery.
